# **REGULATIONS:**

The following are the Regulations for admission into Post Graduate Medical Degree / Diploma Courses under Competent Authority Quota(CQ)/State Quota(SQ) seats in all the Medical Colleges affiliated to Dr.YSR UHS and in Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences (SVIMS), TIRUPATI for the academic year 2023-24.

- 1. NUMBER OF SEATS UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA/STATE QUOTA
- 1.1 <u>Government Medical Colleges</u>: 50% of the total available seats are contributed to AIQ. The Remaining 50% of seats are for State Quota under Competent Authority.

<u>Private Un-Aided Non Minority Medical Colleges</u>: 50% of the total available seats are Competent Authority Quota. Remaining 50% of seats are Management Quota.

1.2 The details of the seats available and Seat matrix under Competent Authority quota for the year 2023-24 will be displayed in the University website before the date of exercising web options.

Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupati (SVIMS):

50% seats of the total available seats are State quota under Competent Authority. The details of the seats available for the academic year i.e., 2023-24 are given in the Page No.38

# 2. ELIGIBILITY

# THE CANDIDATES WHO FULFILL THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA ARE ELIGIBLE:

- 2.1. Candidates should have passed MBBS from a recognized Medical College / University.
- 2.2 NEET PG 2023 CUT OFF SCORE DETAILS: The candidates qualified in NEET PG-2023 examination with the following cutoff scores and above are eligible to apply.

General Category (UR/EWS)	50 <sup>th</sup> percentile	291
SC/ST/BC (Including PwBD of SC/ST/BC)	40 <sup>th</sup> percentile	257
UR-PwBD	45 <sup>th</sup> percentile	274

- 2.3 Candidates should have completed internship latest by **11-08-2023**.
- 2.4 candidates who are going to complete Internship by 11-08-2023 shall submit a certificate duly signed by the Dean/Principal in the prescribed proforma (Annexure-VII)

# 3. RESERVATION IN FAVOUR OF THE LOCAL CANDIDATES:

Admission to 85% of the seats shall be reserved in favour of the local candidates in relation to the local area as provided in A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) order, 1974 for Non-State wide courses as given in Annexure-III of GO (P) No. 646, Edu. (W1) Department, dt.10-7-1979.

# 3.2 STATE-WIDE COURSES:

The courses at Govt. Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada are State-Wide courses and admission into these Courses shall be regulated as per the provisions in the A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) Order, 1974 for State-Wide courses as given in Annexure-IV of GO (P) No. 646, Edu. (W1) Dept, dt.10-7-1979.

# 3.3 LOCAL AREA:

- 3.3.1 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur and Prakasam shall be regarded as the local area for the purposes of admission to the Andhra University, (Nagarjuna University) and to any other Education Institution (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.
- 3.3.2 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Telangana State shall be regarded as local area for the purposes of admission to the Osmania University, (the Kakatiya University) and to any other educational institution (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.
- 3.3.3 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Ananthapur, Kadapa, Kurnool, Chittoor and Nellore shall be regarded as local area for the purposes of admission to Sri Venkateswara University and to any other educational institution (other than a Statewide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.

# 3.4 LOCAL CANDIDATES:

- 3.4.1 A Candidate for admission shall be regarded as local candidate in relation to a local area.
  - i) If he/she studied in an Educational Institution or Educational Institutions in such local area for a period of not less than 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared in relevant qualifying examination.

or

ii) Where during the whole or any part of the 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in Educational Institutions, if he/she had resided in that local area for a period of not less than 4 years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination, in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared.

- 3.4.2 For State Wide Colleges: A candidate who is not regarded as a local candidate under sub-regulation Above in relation to any local area shall
  - i) If he/she has studied in educational institutions in the State for a period of not less than 7 consecutive academic years ending with academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as local candidate in relation to:
    - a) Such local area where he/she has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years.
    - b) Where the period of his/her study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has last studied in such equal periods
      - or
  - ii) If during the whole or any part of the seven consecutive academic years ending with academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in the educational institution in any local area, but he/she has resided in the State during the whole of the said period of 7 years be regarded as a local candidate in relation to
    - a) Such local area where he/she has resided for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years.

or

b) Where the period of his/her residence in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has resided last in such equal periods.

# 3.4.3 As per G.O.Ms.No.101, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dt.15-07-2023 of Govt. of A.P., the following categories of candidates are eligible under 15% of the available unreserved seats in the colleges established before 02.06.2014:

- a) All local candidates defined in the Presidential order.
- b) Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of employment outside the State. (Annexure –III (a) for student) & Annexure III (b) Parent Residence)
- c) Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporation, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi Public Institution within the State; and (Annexure – III (c)).
- d) Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and educational institutions recognized by the Government or University or Other competent authority and similar other quasi Government institutions within the State. (Annexure – III (c) )
- N.B.: The Scanned copies of relevant certificates must be uploaded for verification along with online application. In respect of residence certificate, the certificate should be obtained from the Revenue authorities clearly specifying the years.

# 3.4.4 As per G.O.Ms.No.101, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dt.15-07-2023 of Govt. of A.P, the following categories of candidates are eligible to apply for admission under 15% of the available un-reserved seats for the colleges established and for the seats increased in the State of Andhra Pradesh after 2nd June, 2014.

- a) All the candidates eligible to be declared as local candidates of two local areas of State of Andhra Pradesh.
- b) Candidates who have resided in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a total period of 10 years excluding periods of study outside the State or either of whose parent have resided in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a total period of ten years excluding period of employment outside the State.
- c) Candidates who are children of parents who are in employment of the State of Andhra Pradesh or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions other similar quasi Public Institutions within the State of Andhra Pradesh
- d) Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State of Andhra Pradesh or Central Government, public sector corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions recognized by the Government or University or other Competent Authority and similar quasi Government Institutions within the State of Andhra Pradesh."
- N.B.: The Scanned copies of relevant certificates must be uploaded for verification along with online application. In respect of residence certificate, the certificate should be obtained from the Revenue authorities clearly specifying the years.

# 3.4.5 EXPLANATION: (for purpose of this sub-regulation).

iii)

- i) "Educational Institution" means a University or any Educational Institution recognized by the State Government, a University or any other Competent Authority.
- ii) "Relevant qualifying examination in relation to admission to any course of study" means the examination, a pass in which is the minimum educational qualification for admission to such course of study.
- **NOTE:** The relevant qualifying examination for admission into Post Graduate courses is MBBS examination. The question whether the candidate is a local candidate or not will be determined with reference to his/her first appearance in the Part II of Final MBBS examination.
  - a) In reckoning the consecutive academic years during which a candidate has studied any period of interruption of his/her study by reasons of his/her failure to pass any examination and any period of his/her study in a State wide University or a Statewide Educational Institution shall be disregarded.
    - b) The status of candidates who passed MBBS from Govt. Siddhartha Medical College (State Wide Institution) will be decided basing on their study period prior to their admission into MBBS course at Govt. Siddhartha Medical College for arriving at the local and non-local status, since it is a Statewide Institution.

- iv) The question whether any candidate for admission into any course of study has resided in any local area shall be determined with reference to the places where the candidate actually resided and not with reference to the residence of his/her parent or guardian.
- 3.5 While determining the number of seats to be reserved in favour of local candidates under sub-regulation (3.1), any fraction of seat shall be counted as one, provided that there shall be one unreserved seat.
- 3.6 If a local candidate in respect of a local area is not available to fill any seats reserved or allocated in favour of local candidate in respect of that local area, such seats shall be filled in as if it had not been reserved.
- 3.7 The applicant who claims to be local candidate with reference to sub-regulation 3.4.1 (i) or 3.4.2 (i) shall produce study certificate/certificates issued by the Head of the Educational Institution / Institutions concerned indicating the details of the year or years in which the Candidate has studied in educational institution in such local area for a period of not less than 4/7 consecutive academic years as the case may be ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the Part-II of Final MBBS examination.

Those who did not qualify as local candidate under sub-regulation 3.4.1 (i) and 3.4.2 (ii) but claim to qualify by virtue of residence shall produce a certificate issued by an officer of the Revenue Department not below the rank of Mandal Revenue Officer independent charge of Subtaluk / Mandal in the form annexed to G.O.No.628, Education dt.25-7-1974.

- 3.8 The following categories are eligible to apply for admission to the remaining 15% of un-reserved seats.
- 3.8.1 All candidates defined under sub-regulation (3.4) of Regulation-3.
- 3.8.2 Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding period of study outside the State, or either of those parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding period of employment outside the State.
- 3.8.3 Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar Quasi-Public Institutions in the State.
- 3.8.4 Candidates, who are spouses of those in employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions recognized by the Government or a University or other Competent authority and similar other Quasi Government Institutions within the State.
- 3.8.5 Candidates who are employed in the State Government Undertakings, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi-Public institutions within the State.
- 3.8.6 Candidates who are spouses of the local candidates as per Regulation 3.4

3.8.7 Guidelines vide circular Memo No. 4136/SPF&MC/2015-5, dated 08-08-2016 and 4136/SPF&MC/2015-13, dated. 20.11.2017 of General Administration (SPF & MC), Govt. of AP shall also be observed while determining the local area of a candidate.

NOTE: Relevant scanned original certificates must be uploaded along with application in respect of their claim for 15% Unreserved seats. In respect of proof of 10 years residence, the certificate should be obtained from the Revenue Authorities and the issuing Officer shall not be below the rank of Mandal Revenue Officer / Tahsildar

# 4. SERVICE CANDIDATES:

**Note:** Service rendered up to **30-06-2023** will be considered for considering under Service Category seats.

- (i) If a candidate has already completed PG Degree before joining Government Service, he/she will not be given deputation to do another PG Degree. If a candidate has done PG Diploma course before joining Government Service or after joining Government Service, if he/she is selected for a PG Degree, he/she will be given deputation for 12 months only.
- (ii) In-service candidate shall join the course on or before the commencement of the course after getting relieved from the concerned Head of the Institution. The Heads of the Medical Institutions shall relieve them if they apply for relief enclosing a copy of the selection and allotment order issued by the Competent Authority.
- (iii) All candidates who are In-service seeking admission into PG Courses shall submit application forms with details of service rendered by them in the proforma as per Annexure-IV-A.
- (iv) In-service candidates shall submit service certificate issued only by the concerned Directorate/ Commissionerate in the prescribed form appended as Annexure IV–B.
- (v) As per G.O.Ms.No.150, dt.11-12-2021 of HM&FW(C1) Dept., Government of A.P, the following are the rules for implementing reservations in case of In-service candidates:
- Out of 50% of the seats in State Government quota, 30% of clinical & 50% of non-clinical seats will be exclusively allocated to in service candidates serving in Government Health Institutions in the State of Andhra Pradesh.

As per G.O Ms.No.206, dt.11-08-2022 of HM & FW (C1) Dept., Government of AP, the following rules shall be followed:

• In Tribal areas: Minimum 2 (two) years of regular and continuous service in PHCs/CHCs/Area Hospitals/District Hospitals/Sample Survey cum assessment units/Leprosy temporary hospitalization wards & any Tribal Institute recognized by Government of Andhra Pradesh.

- In Rural areas: Minimum 3 (three) years of regular and continuous service in PHCs/CHCs/Area Hospitals/District Hospitals/MCH/Sample Survey cum assessment units/Leprosy Control Units/Leprosy temporary hospitalization wards/Mobile Medical Units & any Rural Institute recognized by Government of Andhra Pradesh.
- Minimum 6 (six) years of continuous regular service in AP Medical&Health Services/APVVP/AP Insurance Medical Services/University of Health Sciences.

Other conditions governing the In-service candidates:-

- Deputation to in-service candidates selected shall be restricted to 3/2 years only i.e.., 36 months/24 months for PG Degree & Diploma Courses respectively. The in-service candidates selected to prosecute Post Graduate courses shall be sanctioned deputation for one course only in his/her service time.
- In case, if a In-service candidate is selected for PG Diploma Course the candidate may be given deputation, if the candidate is otherwise eligible for a period of 2 years. If a Inservice candidate having a PG Diploma either before entry into Govt. Service or after entry into Govt. Service is selected for a PG degree in any specialty, he/she shall be allowed deputation for another period of 12 months only. No candidate shall be allowed deputation for studying 2<sup>nd</sup> Post Graduate Diploma course under In-service quota.
- In-service candidates shall join the course on or before the commencement of the course after getting relieved from the concerned Head of the Institution. The Heads of the Medical Institutions shall relieve them if they apply for relieving duly enclosing a copy of the Allotment Order issued by the Chairman, Selection Committee.
- After completion of specialization, the in-service doctors to be available to serve in Government facilities in the same area (Tribal/Rural/Continuous regular service) from where the reservation was sought, to a minimum of six (6) years, subject to the availability of vacancies in respective specialities, through a bond as per proforma (Annexure-B) as per G.O.Ms.No.252, dt.07-10-2022 of HM&FW Dept. of Govt. of Andhra Pradesh i.e.,

The University shall cancel the PG (Medical) Degree/Diploma of the candidate and the penalty of indemnity bond shall be Rs.25 Lakhs for non-rendering of services after completion of such course for In-service candidates.

The maximum duration to complete MD/MS is six (6) years from the date of admission including University examinations. The maximum duration to complete PG (Medical) Diploma is four (4) years from the date of admission including University Examinations.

# 5. NON-SERVICE CANDIDATES:

• Each non-service candidate admitted to a P.G course shall execute a bond as per proforma (Annexure-A) to serve the Government for a period of one year. If they violate the bond condition either by not joining or by not completing the stipulated service period of one year within a maximum period of 18 months after obtaining the PG Degree, a penalty of Rs.40,00,000/- shall be levied as per G.O.Ms.No.251, dt.02-10-2022 of HM & FW (C1) Dept., Govt. of AP.

# 6. <u>RESERVATIONS:</u>

6.1 Seats of Post Graduate Degree and Diploma Courses are reserved for SC, ST and BC and BC sub groups as detailed below, which are called vertical reservations.

- 6.2 Candidates claiming reservations under SC/ST/BC categories shall submit a permanent social status certificate issued by Government of Andhra Pradesh/Telangana. The social status of SC/ST/BC candidates shall be subject to the scrutiny as per G.O.Ms.No.58 SW (J) Dept. Dt 12-5-97.
- 6.3 Seats of Post Graduate Degree and Diploma Courses as per NMC, New Delhi guidelines shall be reserved for the following categories of candidates, which are horizontal reservations:

Reservations to Women Candidates - 33 1/3% Reservations to PwBD Candidates - 5%

# 6.4 RESERVATIONS UNDER PwBD CATEGORY:

- 1. There will be 5% Horizontal reservations for PwBD candidates.
- 2. The candidates seeking the benefit of reservation under PwBD category should enclose a valid disability certificate issued not later than **three months(03)** prior to submitting his/her application.
- 3. The guidelines of Govt. of India and regulations of National Medical Council shall be observed in making admissions under PwBD category.
- 4. The Medical Board constituted by the University will scrutinize/verify the disability certificates as per G.O.MS.No.31, Women development, Child welfare & disabled welfare (DW) department, dated.01-12-2009 and candidates claiming reservation under PwBD quota for confirmation of eligibility and the decision of Medical Board specially constituted for the purpose is final and binding on the candidates.

# 7. APPLICATIONS THROUGH ONLINE:

- 7.1 The on-line application forms will be available on the Website <u>https://pgcq.ysruhs.com</u> from <u>11.00 AM on 22-07-2023 to 06.00 PM on</u> <u>31-07-2023.</u>
- 7.2 The candidates are advised to take a print out of the Prospectus / Instructions from the website <u>https://drysr.uhsap.in</u> before proceeding to fill the application form.

The candidate should fill the online application form available on the Website with the data required-for, through internet. The online application form can be filled through any computer with internet connection. The candidate is advised to fill the online application form after going through the Prospectus by keeping all the Certificates ready to enter his/her correct data.

# Procedure of filling online application form and payment of fee through online:

- a. Read the Notification, Prospectus / Regulations carefully regarding eligibility under local and non-local.



# **12. SVIMS, TIRUPATI:**

As per the direction of the Ministry of Health and Family welfare, Govt. of India Vide F.No.V.11011/1/2015-MEP(Pt.), dt.10/03/2017, and as per letter number 420055/C1/2016, dt.28-03-2017 of Principal Secretary to Government, HM&FW Department, Government of A.P., the counseling for admission into PG courses offered by SVIMS, Tirupati shall also be conducted by Dr. YSRUHS.

Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences (SVIMS), Tirupati is a University established by Govt. of AP State Legislature Act 1995 as an autonomous institute. The tuition fee, training, rules and regulations, stipend, bonds, honorarium during compulsory service etc., are as per SVIMS norms appended herewith. The details are also available in the website http://svimstpt.ap.nic.in. For further details contact: 0877-2287777, Ex: 2202, 2267.

# **13. ADMISSION RULES:**

- 13.1 The last date for reporting by the selected candidates at the allotted college will be communicated in the allotment order.
- 13.2. All the candidates including In-service candidates joining the Post Graduate Degree, Diploma courses should execute bond on a stamped paper of ₹. 100/- value as prescribed in Annexure-III to the effect that he / she will complete the prescribed

period of training or in default to pay ₹.3,00,000/- + 18% GST to the University and shall refund the amount received as stipend up to that date to the Government as notified by the University from time to time.

- 13.3 As per G.O.Ms.No.67, HM&FW (C1) Department dated 21-04-2017 candidates have to pay the discontinuation penalty of ₹ 3,00,000/- + 18% GST and they will be debarred for three years for admissions into Post Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma courses at the colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh.
- 14. **ATTENDANCE:** Candidates selected for the various courses shall be the whole-time students. Service candidates will have to apply for leave to prosecute their studies and are required to produce the leave sanction order not later than three months after reporting at the allotted college. The candidate is required to put in a minimum of 80% attendance during each calendar year for being eligible to appear for the University examination.

In a year all 365 days will be considered as working days and students should get 80% attendance each year separately to get eligibility for appearing University exams. The remaining days of absence **(including maternity leave)** will be considered for extension of study period.

- **15. LEAVE:** Students will be permitted to avail 30 days of leave per year. No Post Graduate is allowed to go on leave more than 8 days at a stretch. In case the absence of the candidate availing Medical Leave / Maternity Leave / Any other Leave is beyond 30 days in a year, the study period of the candidate will be extended to the extent of such period.
  - 15.1 **MATERNITY LEAVE:** Women students can avail maternity leave upto 120 days only once in their PG course of study and the study period will be extended to the extent of Maternity leave availed. The candidate shall not be eligible to appear the University examinations till the completion of study period as per NMC, New Delhi Regulations (Duration of course).
  - 15.2 BREAK OF STUDY AND RE-ADMISSION: If a student is absent continuously for a period of 91 days or more and seeks permission to attend the course, his / her application in prescribed format vide Annexures V & VI by paying requisite fee in favour of Registrar, Dr YSR University of Health Sciences payable at Vijayawada shall be forwarded to the Registrar, Dr.YSR University of Health Sciences with the recommendation of the Dean/Principal. The candidates are advised to refer the regulations before submitting the application and paying the fee. If they fulfill the conditions, they may submit applications through the Dean/Principal of the College by paying the fee.
  - **16. PRIVATE PRACTICE:** No Post Graduate is allowed to do any private practice or consultation and should not accept any part time employment in any State or Central or Quasi Government or Private organizations during the period of Post Graduation study. The Principal has to take appropriate action after giving opportunity for explanation, if any student violates this rule.

**17. COLLEGE REGULATIONS:** Candidates are required to follow the rules and regulations of the college and should also abide by the regulations of the University. Under any circumstances candidates should not make any correspondence with the higher authorities of Government/Dr.YSR UHS directly without routing through proper channel.

## **18. CLOSURE OF ADMISSIONS:**

- 18.1 The admissions shall be closed on the date as notified by the University as per NMC, New Delhi norms.
- 18.2 Any vacancy arising on (or) after the date of closure of admissions shall not be filled. They will not be carried forward to the next year as per the directions of Supreme Court of India.

## **19. COMMENCEMENT OF THE COURSE:**

The course shall commence as per the schedule notified.

# **20. DURATION OF COURSE:**

The duration of P.G. Diploma course is 2 years and P.G. Degree course is 3 years including University Examinations. In the case of students having a recognized two year Post Graduate Diploma course in the same subject, the period of training for PG Degree is 2 years including the period of examination. If the break of study is more than 90 days the candidate has to apply (vide Annexure-VI) to the University through the Principal/Dean of the college. The University may give permission to the candidate to complete the course as per the rules of University.

# **21. DISSERTATION:**

The Post Graduates who are admitted must register the topic of their dissertation with the University within six months of commencement of the course and approval of the University should be obtained.

The dissertation should be submitted within 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  years of commencement of the Course. In the case of the candidates who are granted exemption of one year of study period of degree course, the dissertation should be submitted within 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  years of commencement of the course. If the above schedule is not followed the period of Post Graduation will be extended by six months.

21.1 A postgraduate student in broad specialties shall present one poster presentation, to read one paper at a National/State conference and to present one research paper which should be published/ accepted for publication/sent for publication during the period of his/her Postgraduate study so as to make him/her eligible to appear for the Postgraduate Degree University examinations.

21.2 The UGC Notification, dt.23-07-2018 published in the Gazette of India regarding "Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational Institutions, Regulations 2018" are in force from the academic year 2021-22.

# 22. MIGRATION AND TRANSFER OF CANDIDATES:

Migration/Transfer/Mutual transfer of Post Graduate students from one medical college to another Medical College, from one course to another course and from Degree to Diploma and vice versa are not allowed under any circumstances.

## 23. POWERS OF PRINCIPALS:

Notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations, the Principals of Medical Colleges in the State may at any time before completion of the Post Graduate course either on their own or on the application of any person after due and proper enquiry and after giving the person two weeks time from the date of the receipt of the show cause notice to submit written explanation and on personal hearing, order, cancellation of admission to the 1<sup>st</sup> year Post Graduate Degree/Diploma course if in his/her opinion such candidate had furnished incorrect particulars/false information in the certificates or in the documents attached thereto or in the Statements made either before the authority in charge of admission or the Principals or in any other manner. Against any such order of the Principal, an appeal shall lie with the Registrar, Dr. YSR University of Health Sciences, A.P. Vijayawada.

## 24. POWERS OF DR.YSR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES:

Dr. YSR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada may either suomoto or on an application made to them, call for and examine the records relating to any selection or admission thereof in respect of the admission made by the concerned authority, for the purpose of satisfying themselves as to the correctness of legality or propriety of such selection or cancellation and pass such order in relation there to as they deem fit including cancellation of the selection already published or admission already made, provided that the University may, before canceling such selection or admission, give an opportunity to the authority and to the person affected to show cause against such cancellation. Dr.YSR UHS has every right to cancel the admission of any candidate without any notice, if the certificates produced by the candidate are found to be fake/ false/forged

# Note: If a candidate is found to have submitted false information such candidate is liable to be disqualified for admission and in case already admitted, the admission will be cancelled. Further disciplinary action against him/her will be initiated by the University as per rules.

#### 25. RAGGING:-

The candidates who join PG (Medical) Courses should not indulge in any kind of agitation / strike / ragging activity inside / outside the college campus during the course of study. The candidates if found to take part in any such activities mentioned above will be expelled from the course / college at any part of the course of study and legal proceedings / criminal action will be initiated against them. A copy of the National Medical Commission (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Medical Colleges and Institutions) Regulations, 2021 is also available in University website for information.

**26.** The candidates applying for PG (Medical) Courses for the academic year 2023–24 are deemed to have read the contents in the Prospectus and agree with all conditions / clauses and will not have the right to challenge any of the clauses contained in the Prospectus and agree that the same is binding upon them.

#### 3. RULES & REGULATIONS

i) The courses are full time courses. The candidate shall be full time resident. No postgraduate is allowed to do any private practice or consultation and shall not accept any part time employment in any state or central or Quasi Government or private organizations during the period of Post Graduate study. If any student violates this rule, appropriate action shall be taken.

#### ii) FEES:

- 3. At the time of reporting for admission, the candidate has to pay

- d) The demand draft (DD) shall be drawn in favour of, "The Director, SVIMS, Tirupati", payable at Tirupati. The DDs shall be drawn on or after commencement of admission schedule.

(b) will not be refunded, the rest of the fees will be returned.

#### iii) Hostel Accommodation:

i. Shared accommodation will be provided to the candidates on rent fixed as per rules of the institute subject to availability. They will have to necessarily stay in the accommodation.

ii. The students are required to vacate the hostel accommodation within seven days of the completion of their course failing which Rs. 100/- and Rs. 200/- per day will be levied for bachelor and married hosteller respectively as penal rent for unauthorized occupancy of hostel accommodation. Under such circumstances, the room will be vacated/ evicted by the hostel authority/security staff during the unauthorized stay.

iii. The students will be responsible for proper upkeep of the furniture and other fixtures of the room. In case of damage/loss, a penalty would be imposed as assessed by the wardens of the hostels.

iv. No electrical/civil alternation in the room is allowed.

v. Use of air conditioner /heaters and other electrical appliances consuming high electrical energy is not permitted in the hostel.

vi. Hostel facility is available for the candidates who satisfy the following:

a. Payment of caution deposit of Rs.5,000/-(refundable) and hostel establishment fund (Corpus fund)of Rs.5,000/- (Non-refundable) to be paid on the day of allotment of hostel accommodation.

b. The mess charges shall be borne by the students apart from the hostel establishment charges as applicable.

At the time of allotment of hostel, the candidate has to pay 01 year mess establishment charges.

#### iv) Stipend:

Monthly stipend as per SVIMS rules shall be paid to the candidate admitted to the course for the period not exceeding 36 months, taking their monthly attendance into consideration. At present they are being paid monthly salary of Rs.80,904/-, 83,216/- and 85,528/- respectively during I, II and III year course of study.

**Note:** In-service candidates will not be paid stipend if he/she draws leave salary in their parent institution.

#### v) Resident's Manual:

After admission, each Postgraduate Resident will be issued a copy of the Resident's manual. The manual consists of the duties, responsibilities, attendance, leave, academics, thesis writing and other guidelines to be followed during the training period. A copy of the resident's manual for the year 2022 is available for reference in the institute website: <a href="http://www.svimstpt.ap.nic.in">http://www.svimstpt.ap.nic.in</a>.

#### vi) Log Book:

The candidate shall maintain a log book. There shall be entry of various special investigations done, procedures, operations performed etc., by the candidate during the study period certified by the head of the department. The Log book shall be submitted to the examiners at the time of practical and viva voce.

#### vii) Duties and responsibilities:

Duties and responsibilities of students joining PG (MD/MS) medical courses shall be fixed by the Institute from time to time. They will be required to pursue such works that may be needed in the legitimate interest of the patient care in the hospital. The service of the post graduate resident may be terminated without any prior notice by the Directorcum-Vice Chancellor on the following grounds:

1. If SVIMS is satisfied on medical evidence that the resident is unfit and is likely to remain so for a considerable period, for reasons of ill health and unable to discharge his / her duties. The decision of the Director-cum-VC, whether the Resident is unfit and is likely to continue to remain unfit, shall be conclusive and binding on him / her.

2. If the resident is found to be guilty of insubordination, interference with the patient care/university administration or misconduct.

3. If any resident is absent continuously for more than 30 days without any intimation to the office, course completion certificate will be issued and deemed penalty will be levied.

4. If the certificates submitted by him/ her at the time of joining the course are found to be not genuine by competent authority at any time during or after the course his / her Degree is liable to be cancelled.

**viii)** The Performance of the candidates joining the course will be evaluated periodically by a committee constituted for the purpose and in case of unsatisfactory performance, the Institute has the right to take appropriate action to extend the period of training or detain the candidate and make him/her ineligible for appearing for final examination including the removal of the name of the candidate from the rolls of the institute.

#### ix) Library:

There is a well established separate library building in 45,000 sq.ft. available in SVIMS Campus with good collection of (20921) books with subscription for 149 print journals (88 foreign and 60 Indian ). The library has back volume journal collection of 7184 dating back to 1993. The Library is well equipped with modern facilities such as elearning to access internet and web resources including online journals and e-books. All library services are being automated on modern line by adopting KOHA Library Automation Software. The computerization of collections is under process which will be accessible through OPAC. There is a computer lab consists of 15 nodes to access eresources for library users on free of cost. The main thrust of the library continues to be improvement, of quality of services and facilities, achieving high degree of user satisfaction and modernization of its activities and operations. It has Scanning and Photocopying facilities for library users. The Library is kept open for 363 days in a year except Jan 26<sup>th</sup> and Aug 15<sup>th</sup> and functions 16 hours a day i.e. 8 a.m. to 12 Midnight. During festivals, holidays and Sundays, it works from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. The National medical Library, New Delhi providing membership in ERMED consortium to access 228+ e-journals with back issues.

#### x) Warning:

In case any candidate is found to have supplied false information or certificate or is found to have withheld or concealed certain information, he/she shall be debarred from continuing the course and shall face such appropriate action initiated against him/her by the Institute and his/her name will be referred to NMC/Medical Council of India.

#### xi) Discipline:

The students shall maintain strict discipline during the period of study/training program in terms of conduct rules of the institute. The candidates shall not resort to any strikes during the period of their study. The students are not permitted in criticizing the policies of the Institute either before the print or electronic media or anywhere which amounts to dereliction of duties. Their grievances (if any) may be submitted to the Dean through proper channel. They are not permitted to approach the legal authorities/ NMC/MCI/ Govt. without prior permission by the institution. In case of violation of the conduct rules, the admission of the candidate is liable for cancellation apart from invoking the terms and conditions of the bond.

#### xii) Ragging:

Ragging is prohibited in the Educational Institutions in the State of Andhra Pradesh, vide.Act.No.26 of 1997, dated 21-08-1997 & amendments made from time to time and NMC/Medical Council of India (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Medical Colleges/ Institutions) Regulations, 2009 issued vide notification dated 03-08-2009.

If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the student concerned shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/ her from the Institution and the information will be forwarded to NMC/ Medical Council of India for taking necessary action.

After admission, each candidate has to submit an affidavit duly signed by self and parent /guardian. The affidavit is available in the website <u>www.amanmovement.org</u>.

**xiii)** The rules are subject to change in accordance with the Institute's policy taken from time to time.

#### xiv) Powers of Dean:

Notwithstanding anything contained therein, the Dean, SVIMS may at any time before completion of the course either on his/her own motion or on the application of any person after due and proper enquiry and after giving the person two weeks time from the date of receipt of the show cause notice to submit the written explanation and on personal hearing, order the cancellation of admission to the course, if in his/her opinion such candidate had furnished incorrect particulars/false information or in the certificates or in the statement made either before the Dean or any other manner. Against any such order of the Dean, the appeal shall lie with the Director-cum-VC, SVIMS, Tirupati.

#### xv) Indemnity Bonds:

- The selected candidates have to execute two bonds. The proforma of the Indemnity Bonds are available at Appendix-I, which are to be submitted on or before the date of commencement of the course and receive the admission order.
- 2. The candidate shall execute the Indemnity Bond I on a stamp paper (non-judicial) of Rs.100/- value, that, in the event of the candidate discontinuing the studies at any time during the course, he/she shall be bound to pay a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five lakhs only) + GST as applicable along with the full stipend amount received by him/her back to the Institute.
- 3. The candidate shall also execute another bond (Indemnity Bond II), that in the event of not willing to work in the post and pay offered by the institute after successful completion of the course for a period of one year, he/she shall be bound to pay a sum of Rs.40,00,000/- (Rupees Forty lakhs only) + GST as applicable.
- 4. The bonds requires Two Sureties from Gazetted officers of State/Central Govt.

#### xvi) Compulsory Service:

As per G.O.Ms. No. 251 dated 02-10-2022 Govt. of Andhra Pradesh all the post graduates joined in SVIMS have to do compulsory service for a period of one year after successful completion of the course immediately. Those who are in-service candidates and who are selected in DM/MCh course are exempted from compulsory service. During their service, they will be paid honorarium.

In the event of not willing to do compulsory service after successful completion of the course, he/she shall be bound to pay a sum of Rs.40,00,000/- (Rupees Forty lakhs only)+ GST as mentioned under BONDS above. Unnecessary delay in joining without any valid reason will lead to execution of bond and withhold of degree certificate.

**xvii)** Andhra Pradesh Medical Council registration is to be done immediately after admission i.e. within 01 month from the date of admission. Without registration the residents can't attend to patients.

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#### FREQENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

## Q. No. 1: When will PG(Medical) Allotments start for State Quota (also called Competent Authority Quota) seats?

**Ans:** The schedule will be as per NMC, New Delhi guidelines and you have to visit University Website regularly for updates.

### Q. No. 2: Is a candidate required to report to any center for online Registration and Web options?

Ans: The entire process is online only. Not required to report at any center for Registration and Web options

## Q.No.3. Is one online application is sufficient for both SQ/CQ and Management Quota seats?

Ans: Separate applications are required to be submitted for SQ/CQ and MQ seats. Visit University website for SQ/CQ and MQ Notifications.

## .Q.No.4: How many Phases of counselling will be conducted by Dr.YSR UHS for State Quota/Competent Authority Quota seats?

Ans: As per Guidelines/Schedule given by NMC, New Delhi and also keeping in view of the last date for admissions, possible number of Phases will be conducted.

#### Q.No.5: What is the cut-off date of Internship?

Ans: 11<sup>th</sup> August-2023 is the cut-off date for Internship.

### Q. No. 6: What is the mode of reporting at the allotted college. Do I have to report personally at the allotted College?

Ans: The allotted candidate has to download the allotment letter by paying Rs.23,600/- through online mode. Candidates who are allotted seats should report at the allotted colleges along with all **Original Certificates, allotment letter and Provisional Verification Form** on or before the last date mentioned in the Allotment letter, failing which the candidate is deemed to be **NOT REPORTED** and that seat will be filled in next phase of counselling as per Rules.

#### Q.No.7: What is the process of Web options?

Ans: A candidate has to opt for the interested specialties and colleges before commencement of each phase of counselling as and when the Notification is released by Dr.YSR UHS, Vijayawada.

#### Q. No. 8: Is there any restriction for filling the number of web options?

Ans: One candidate can give any number of web options. However, the candidates are advised to exercise web options for the course in which they are really interested to join.

### Q. No.9: Is it necessary to join in allotted seat of Phase-I to get chance to participate in Phase-II?

Ans: If a candidate does not report at the allotted institute in Phase-I, this will be considered as 'Free Exit' (this facility is available only in Phase-I). Candidates who have not joined the Phase-I allotted seat may participate again in Phase-II.

However, if satisfied with the seat allotted in Phase-I, it is not required to participate in further rounds. Rules on Retain and Exit option will be issued in detail in the Notifications. Candidates shall go through the Notification carefully.

#### Q.No.10: Who are eligible for exercising web options in Phase-II?

#### Ans:

a) Candidates who participated in Phase-I, but did not get any seat allotted in the Phase-I.

b) Candidates who have reported/joined in the allotted seat of Phase-I

c) Candidates who have not reported/joined in the allotted seat of Phase-I

### **Q.** No. 11: If sufficient number of qualified PwBD candidates are not available then, what will happen to those un-allotted PG seats, reserved for PwBD candidates?

Ans: The un-allotted PG seats earmarked for PwBD will be reverted/converted to respective categories of same area as PwBD reservations are Horizontal reservations only.

Ex: BC-A - PwBD(G) to -BC-A(G)SC -PwBD(F) to -SC(F)

#### Q. No. 12: Will I get any personal intimation regarding schedules and allotments?

Ans: No. The candidates have to visit University website regularly for notifications/schedules

### Q. No. 13: Can I modify my web options during the choice submission for a particular Phase of counseling?

Ans: Yes, you can modify, add or delete your web options before you submit your web options. However, once web options are submitted, they cannot be modified later under any circumstances.

- a) In a particular college MD(RD) seat is under "Open Category" in the seat matrix and a SC candidate is allotted that Open Category MD(RD) seat in Open Round Counselling of Phase-I as per his/her web options and NEET Rank merit order of the candidate. Now this candidate is shown as **Meritorious Reserved Candidate** (MRC).
- b) The same SC candidate has slided to MD (General Medicine) SC category seat in the same college or another college during the Category Round of Phase-I Counselling conducted on the same day, then that MD(RD) seat vacated by this MRC candidate shall be filled with the SC candidates only by merit amongst them.
- c) This type of MRC concept is to be followed for all BC/SC/ST categories in order to maintain 50 : 50 ratio of Open : Category Reservation
